## **Lead-Based Paint Disclosure**



Complete this form ONLY if housing was built before January 1, 1978 and attach this form to the *Request for Tenancy Approval*. Housing built before 1978 may contain lead-based paint. Lead from paint, paint chips, and dust can pose health hazards if not managed properly. Lead exposure is especially harmful to young children and pregnant women. Before renting pre-1978 housing, landlords must disclose the presence of known lead-based paint and/or lead-based paint hazards in the dwelling.

Renters must also receive a federally approved pamphlet on lead poisoning prevention. Alaska Housing Finance Corporation has provided the pamphlet, *Protect Your Family from Lead in Your Home*.
