Re: SFY 2025 Basic Homeless Assistance Program Award Process

Dear SFY 2024 Basic Homeless Assistance Program Grantees,

Basic Homeless Assistance Program (BHAP) grants awarded through the SFY24 funding cycle will be renewed for the next (SFY25) funding cycle as authorized in Section 19 of the SFY24 Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA). The SFY24 NOFA and terms of the SFY24 grant agreements, and related amendments, remain in effect for the SFY25 renewal process.







AHFC anticipates approximately \$6.5 million will be available through the SFY25 renewal process. Thus, grantees may request renewal funding in an amount not to exceed their SFY24 award. AHFC reserves the right to adjust awards based on final legislative appropriation as outlined in the SFY24 NOFA.

Renewal grantees will be required to submit the following via email to process the renewal award:

- SFY25 BHAP Renewal Grant Coversheet
- Program Details Form
- Budget Workbook
- Budget Narrative
- Match/Leverage Form

Renewal grant documentation will be available via email and published on the AHFC website on July 3, 2024.

Deadline for submission of all renewal forms is August 16, 2024, by 4:30 p.m.
