### **Poverty Guidelines for Alaska**

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services updates poverty guidelines for the nation each year. The guidelines are adjusted based on increases in prices as measured by the Consumer Price Index. This year's guidelines were published on February 1, 2021 in the *Federal Register* as [FR Doc. 2021-01969](#).

Beginning with the effective date of this Exhibit, use these annual income figures when determining if a family meets the poverty guidelines.

<b>Number of Persons in the Family</b>	<b>Annual Income</b>
1	\$16,090
2	\$21,770
3	\$27,450
4	\$33,130
5	\$38,810
6	\$44,490
7	\$50,170
8	\$55,850

For families with more than eight persons, add \$5,680 for each additional person.
