2012 Golf Tournament pushes AHFC over \$100K in Charitable Giving

Anchorage, Alaska, AUGUST 28, 2012— Alaska Housing Finance Corporation (AHFC) management announced today they raised more than \$15,000 at the 2012 Mulligans Masters Charity Golf Tournament held on June 21. Proceeds from the event will be gifted to two charities—Access Alaska and Children's Meal Mission. Both organizations provide critical services in Alaska. Access Alaska promotes independence for Alaska seniors and individuals with disabilities, and Children's Meal Mission provides meals for hungry youth. The funds raised during this year's event bring AHFC's total contributions since 2005 to statewide charities over the \$100,000 mark.

"AHFC touches a lot of Alaskans in a lot of ways but broadly, we're about making Alaska a better place to live," said Dan Fauske, AHFC CEO. "You can see this in the work we do but you can also see it in the way that our employees and our sponsors work together to support these critical charities."
