Notice of Alaska Council on the Homeless Meeting Today

ANCHORAGE, AK – The Fall meeting of the Alaska Council on the Homeless (ACOTH) is scheduled for today, October 9. The meeting will be held in the first floor boardroom at Alaska Housing Finance Corporation (AHFC) from 1 p.m. – 4 p.m. The meeting will include a status report on homelessness in Alaska and a discussion of federal program updates, among other agenda items.

ACOTH was established in 2004 by Administrative Order 214. A dozen members from state and federal agencies were appointed to prepare recommendations on how state resources could be directed toward ending homelessness. The current Council membership includes AHFC, the Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority, the Alaska State Departments of Education, Public Safety, Corrections and Health and Social Services and six public members from the homeless provider community, rural housing authorities, local government and the real estate industry.
