Basic Homeless Assistance Program (BHAP) grants awarded through the SFY24 funding cycle will be renewed for the next (SFY26) funding cycle as authorized in Section 19 of the SFY24 Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA). The SFY24 NOFA and terms of the SFY24 grant agreements, as well as related amendments, remain in effect for the SFY26 renewal process. SFY 26 renewals will include a 3% inflation adjustment increase.



AHFC anticipates that approximately \$6.6 million will be available through the SFY26 renewal process. Thus, grantees may request renewal funding not exceeding their SFY24 award plus a 3% inflation adjustment increase for SFY26. AHFC reserves the right to adjust awards based on final legislative appropriation as outlined in the SFY24 NOFA.
