ADDENDUM NO. 1

QUESTIONS RECEIVED BY AHFC FOR CLARIFICATION:

QUESTION 1:	What is your estimated budget for year 1?
ANSWER:	An estimated budget for year one has not been established. Funding awards to successful respondents will depend on funding available to AHFC. It is anticipated funding awards may range between \$10,000 and \$500,000. Multiple funding awards may be made depending on specified programs.
QUESTION 2:	Will the audience for the activities be primarily homeowners, renters, or housing professionals, or a combination of those or other audiences? If combination, what is the anticipated/desired time or budget split of the audiences for the activities that the grantee(s) are expected to spend? (for example, 40/40/20 homeowners / renters / housing professionals)
ANSWER	Funding awards to successful respondents will target homeowners, renters, and housing professionals. An allocation of funding between the
