

# 504 Equal Access Statement

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Alaska Housing Finance Corporation (AHFC) conducts its business in accordance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and Federal Fair Housing Law. AHFC does not discriminate because of race, color, sex, religion, familial status, disability, or national origin in admission or access to, or treatment or employment in, its federally assisted programs and activities. Individuals may review AHFC's Fair Housing policies during working hours. An appointment may be necessary to review the entire contents of these policies.

A person with disabilities may request a reasonable accommodation by completing a Reasonable Accommodation Request available at any AHFC office. AHFC will conduct all hearings or meetings required in the administration of public and assisted housing programs in an accessible location with appropriate assistance provided if requested by a person with disabilities.

For individuals with impaired vision, AHFC will provide assistance to help review AHFC documents. Assistance may include describing the contents of the document, reading aloud sections or the entire document, or providing other reasonable assistance as may be needed.

For individuals with impaired hearing, AHFC will provide assistance including the provision of a sign language interpreter at a time convenient to both AHFC and the hearing-impaired individual. Persons who are deaf, hard-of-hearing, or speech disabled may use Alaska Relay. Dial 7-1-1 to place a relay call.
